At Martha we pride ourselves on offering much more than the basic level of care.

We offer a comprehensive activities programme enabling our residents to enjoy a fulfilling life, despite their disabilities. It is important to us that we offer a wide range of internal and external activities, so our residents have choice. Everything

we offer is specifically tailored to their needs. The positive effects on their health and wellbeing are endless. They smile more, are more relaxed, and it helps them develop confidence and social abilities.

Our activity teams are at the heart of this and offer a daily programme of activities across our homes which take place on site and include arts and crafts, singing, music, team games, sensory cooking and gardening.

Our residents especially love the tactile nature of the art sessions and they have been known to get rather messy!

The works of art get shared with their loved ones and across Martha, with

our walls and noticeboards adorned with their paintings and creations. These activities were even more important during the pandemic when our guys and girls were unable to go out and about and enjoy the external activities they love.

Throughout the year we host themed days at home, which involve making decorations, dressing up, parties, themed food and entertainment. We are not sure who enjoys these days more, our residents or the teams at Martha!

Some of our most recent party days have included a 'Grease lightening' day at our homes in Deal and a

'Disney day' at Mary House, our home in Hastings. The work and effort that goes into making these days such fun never ceases to amaze us. Some of the outfits, we think you will agree, were incredible.

Our activities programme also helps the individuals who live at Martha to try new things, learn new skills, and take part in sports

and activities they may not previously have had access to. The external activities we offer enable our residents to get out and about into the local community to enjoy new and exhilarating experiences. From carriage riding, sailing, theatre and even boat trips on the Wetwheels experience, there is something for everyone.

Day trips to local attractions are always popular too, and we are especially lucky that our homes are based in coastal towns, providing the simple pleasures of a stroll along the promenade, an ice cream on the pier and fish and chips by the sea. As the Covid restrictions have lifted we have cautiously reintroduced outdoor day trips, much to the delight of our residents.

With 2022 marking our 35th anniversary our activity teams have lots of exciting things planned to celebrate this landmark year with our residents, their families and staff at Martha.

A double helping of brilliance in the kitchens

Juliette and Adele head up our amazing kitchen teams at Martha. They are passionate about their roles and the importance that well-balanced, nutritious home-cooked food has to play on our residents' health through their diet. Their love of food and understanding of nutrition for our client group shines through in their menus. All our kitchens have a 5 star food hygiene rating which the teams work incredibly hard to maintain.

The kitchen teams are a friendly bunch, approachable, happy to listen and they always welcome ideas to improve the menu choices. They encourage the care teams, residents and their families to put forward new recipes and ideas to add to the menu board.



Adele has recently stepped up to managing the kitchen teams at our Deal homes. She has brought lots of new ideas with her and has introduced ingredients with

proven health benefits into everyday cooking. The team now incorporate coconut oil and/or turmeric in a meal most days because of their proven health benefits. "I'm only talking of a small amount but hope that in time, this will help reduce seizures, lower blood pressure and ease joint pain even if by only a fraction, at least we are heading in the right direction. We have introduced new recipes including pork 'n' prunes, honey, dates, chickpea puree to mention just a few."



Juliette has been managing the kitchen at Mary House in Hastings for seven years. When asked what she likes most about working at Martha, she said "you can feel the

love when you walk through the door." She also values the feedback she receives from family members, one of whom sent her a card recently addressed to the "Chef Extraordinaire", thanking her for the time she had spent developing meals for their son to enjoy.

Juliette feels a great sense of responsibility and, like Adele, has to understand the individual Speech and Language Therapy guidelines for each resident in terms of food textures, along with knowing about their allergies and, most importantly, what their favourite foods are!

Both kitchen teams work closely with their respective Activities Co-ordinators to tweak the menu to coincide with the many theme days they organise throughout the year. The celebrations to mark the Chinese New Year included Hoisin and Ginger Chicken and noodles with Prawn crackers, which got the thumbs up. And to mark Valentine's day all the residents had special personalised edible decorated plates. The Caribbean Day saw a menu of curry, jerk chicken, plantain and rice and peas. It's no wonder everyone at Martha looks forward to theme days!

We can't wait to see what Adele and Juliette have planned in the months to come. Everyone at Martha has a key role to play in delivering the very best level of support for our residents and as a team we are constantly striving to do more.
