

to avoid disappointing
the residents, as well as
them missing out on
the benefits of their
hydro sessions. Being in
warm water, free of the
constraints of a wheelchair
and almost weightless,
allows for play, games

and therapeutic exercise

which can relieve pain and boost the immune system.

So that morning, Natalie,
Martha's Resident
Engagement &
Communication Lead,
had a discussion with the
dedicated hydro team and
together they came
up with a plan for the
week. It was decided

week. It was decided that two of the hydro team would go up into the main houses and give five residents a musical spa bath daily, so they at least didn't lose out on a fun water experience that week.

All of our residents love hydrotherapy!

This plan just needed Clive. Knowing that Clive is very hands on and loves DIY, Natalie had a chat with him about an idea she had to jazz up the white walls of the hydropool while it was out of action. Natalie had carried out a little research and figured out that the residents living at Martha who are partially sighted, or have any sight problems, would benefit from some dark shapes on the white wall. The theory was the images would stand out more and they would perhaps be able to see them better.

Clive was thrilled with the idea, so he and Natalie put their heads together and came up with the idea of sea creatures in a very dark navy against a white wall. That morning Clive got his head down and started drawing the creatures on the wall. After just five days he had completely finished, leaving us with fantastic results!


The next step was to test if their research was correct, so Natalie went into the house and took a couple of residents down into the hydropool to show them the new look. Wow! They all spotted the new artwork straight away, with one person even naming every sea

creature he could see on the wall.
